VOLUNTEERING RULES

INTRODUCTION:

Between **July 15 and September 16, 2017**, Vila Nova de Cerveira hosts the **XIX Cerveira International Art Biennial**, being the oldest in Portugal, is also the oldest of the Iberian Peninsula in activity that constitutes itself as an **important** event which helps to disclose Cerveira and contributes decisively to this village being known as the 'Village of Arts'.

Based on a cultural decentralization strategy and international dimension of the event, and in order to present the latest artistic accomplishments and aesthetic trends, the XIX Cerveira International Art Biennial extends thus its exhibition area from the Cultural Forum to other outdoor spaces, in the municipality, as well as in northern Portugal and Galicia.

The program includes: International Competition, Universities representations, Schools and Polytechnics of artistic fields, national and international curators and guest artists, Honoured Artists, Concerts, conferences and debates, ateliers and workshops.

In this context, the cooperation of the volunteer is essential for the organization of this event, specifically, the host to all visitors, as well as in the daily organization of diverse tasks required in each exhibition space.

ABOUT VOLUNTEERING:

According to Law No. 71/98 from 3 November, on the basis of the legal framework of volunteering:

- *The "Volunteering is the set of actions of social interest and community performed selflessly by people in the context of projects, programs and other forms of assistance to the service of individuals, families and the community developed nonprofit by public or private entities" (Article 2, No. 1)*

AND

- *"The volunteer is the individual in a free, unselfish and responsible undertakes, in accordance with their own skills and in their free time, to perform **volunteering** actions within a promoting organization" (Article 3rd, No. 1).*

GENERAL CONSIDERATIONS:

- The voluntary work will begin on **July 1st, and end on September 30th, 2017**, provided under the project "XIX Cerveira International Art Biennial" ,
- The Cerveira Biennial Art Foundation guarantees Volunteers of the "XIX International Cerveira Art Biennial", according to the legislation in force (Law No. 71/98 of 3rd November and Decree-Law No. 389/99 of 30th September, on the basis of the legal framework of volunteering) training, food, accommodation, insurance and Certificate of Participation.
- Each volunteer will make a turn to a maximum of five hours a day for 15 days and will have two days off per week.
- The volunteer will work in the following areas: support in the assembly and disassembly of exhibitions, support for receiving visitors and participants, support in organizing guided tours and supporting the dissemination of exhibitions, activities and events related to the "XIX International Cerveira Art Biennial".
- Registration of volunteers for the "XIX Cerveira International Art Biennial", will take place from **April 3rd to May 31th, 2017**.
- Volunteer will be adjusted with the responsible of the project, the days, times and places during "XIX International Biennial of Cerveira Art".

CRITERIA:

- All interested in signing up as volunteers for the "XIX Cerveira International Art Biennial" should be aged between 18 and 30 years;
